Why celebrate the coronation of Charles III?

We all used to be 'Elizabethans' now we are all 'Charlies'! Known for his good humour, our new King Charles III was brought up in the 'swinging sixties'. So, what's better celebration than Party Time?

The era the future King Charles III grew up in shaped his interests in environmental causes. The 1960's brought significant changes to our society which are still with us today. Television brought the biggest change to people's lives as three quarters of the population had access to TV. Sales of other luxuries, such as washing machines and fridges rose dramatically. Local Council cleared slum housing and millions of people moved from rented to home ownership.

What happens during a coronation?

King Charles III acceded to the throne on 8 September 2022, upon the death of his mother, Queen Elizabeth II. The coronation is a state occasion. It will take place on Saturday 6th May 2023 and to be shorter, more inclusive, and less expensive than previous coronations.

King Charles III will dress in his finery and take a coronation oath, be anointed with consecrated oil, and receive the orb and sceptre, and be crowned with St Edward's Crown.

The Coronation is a "solemn, religious service" paired with an "occasion for celebration and pageantry". The service will "reflect the monarch's role today and look towards the future, while being rooted in longstanding traditions and pageantry".

There are parking restrictions operating within the town.








