Welcome

Welcome to this wonderful building which has been a place of prayer since 1801.

The Brixham Baptist congregation was initially a gathering of believers sent out from Dartmouth Baptist Church in 1799. Despite local opposition the chapel was constructed and completed in 1801.

The church was built to a traditional design. Tidal flows reached the area now the main town car park. Stone for this Church was quarried locally in Fore Street (which became the location of Brixham Methodist Church).

The Brixham Baptist congregation has been long associated with reaching out the local community. We have a long history of working with children and families. Annual Sunday school outings were held and thronged in the streets with hundreds turning out to participate or watch.

Today, we are a thriving church linked to over 200 people, mainly based in the town, a quarter of whom are children and their families. We welcome all people whatever their age or situation, who want a relaxed style of service and want to explore a life lived with Jesus.
