We will shortly issue formal invites for limited (30 people) with buffet lunch afterwards in Birdcage.

PA reported that substantial funds 'earmarked' for Brixham. JB expressed some pessimism as UK general finances not

good. Also capital funding 'bidding' against other VFM projects both Torbay wide and then nationwide.

13) Potential New Project-Brixham Fish Market Panels

Board disappointed Dave Hodgetts unable to attend. JB said project `oven ready` and quick win –but cost circa £3K. Board requested item move to next meeting.

14) Potential New Project –Festival of the Sea

Initial work completed –but big issues such as funding /participation remained to ensure viability.

15) Website/Mobile Application

We had managed to resolve website with help from local volunteer. Nothing progressed on Mobile App to date due to time limitations etc.

16) Update on sales of 4th round NT Lottery

JR reported 525 tickets sold to date. The Brixham Lottery could provide us with an independent income. The tickets made excellent presents for any occasion with good odds etc. Draw to occur after this meeting at 730pm.

We had managed to negotiate a deal with Dobles for £1,000 first Prize. The new cards would be on sale after the NT Draw this evening at usual local outlets. We had delivered/circulated 10,000 printed leaflets on Brixham Lottery.

We had printed above in anticipation of distribution in January and Draw in June (hopefully at the Torbay Air-show). JR would lead on this.
